## **PowerPoint: Sharing Slides**

Scenario: You need to create a presentation and find that a slide from another presentation could be useful in this new presentation. Why re-invent the wheel?

- 1. Open both presentations.
- 2. Make sure both presentations are displayed in SLIDE SORTER VIEW (the four little white squares at the

bottom-right corner of the window.

- 3. In the presentation from which you want to steal a slide RIGHT-CLICK the slide you want and choose COPY.
- 4. Switch over to the other presentation.
- 5. Point to the slide which you want the soon-to-be-added slide to follow and click your RIGHT mouse button.
- 6. You will see three paste options:
  - a. Choose USE DESTINATION THEME if you want the new slide to look like a part of the presentation to which it is being added; or
  - b. Choose KEEP SOURCE FORMATTING if you want it to look like it come from another presentation (keeping the original presentation theme/fonts/etc).
  - c. Choose PICTURE to add an image of the slide to the selected slide.
