#### These Are a Few of My Favourite Things

## My favourite shortcut in WORD

[ALT][SHFT] ↑ and [ALT][SHFT] ↓ for moving entire paragraphs (or table rows) UP or DOWN a document....without even having to select it first (just place your cursor somewhere in the para).

# My favourite shortcut in **GENERAL**

Holding down the [CTRL] key and rolling the mouse wheel forward (to ZOOM any screen bigger) or back towards you (to ZOOM any screen smaller).

My favourite shortcut in

**EXCEL** 

The keyboard shortcut [CTRL] +

a selected column or row.

It's best on a full keyboard

and [CTRL] - to insert (or delete)

because you have the + and - on

the numeric keypad way over at

the right side of the keyboard.

If I receive a question or task by email that I want to act on — but I'm too busy at the moment...I drag the email to the CALENDAR icon (bottom of Outlook screen) — and drop it. It turns into an appointment that I can set a reminder for.

# My favourite shortcut in WINDOWS 7

When I click the Windows START button and I don't see the program I am looking for...rather than going looking for it — I just type the first few letters of the program name...and it appears at the top of the list for me.

## My favourite shortcut in **POWERPOINT**

When I need to drag an item level (not wavering slightly up or down) – I hold down the [SHFT] key when I drag (with the mouse) the object. Guaranteed to travel straight.
